

# New COVID requirements for Mangles Bay Fishing Club

---

1. All MBFC members who are NOT double vaccinated **must not** enter the Club's licensed areas (ie the Clubroom and adjacent alfresco areas) which includes both the male and female toilet blocks from the **31st of January 2022**.
2. Members who have received a Medical Exemption from COVID Vaccinations from the WA Chief Health Officer may enter the Club's licenced areas however those members **must** provide evidence of the exemption by email to [secretary@manglesbay.com.au](mailto:secretary@manglesbay.com.au) or a Committee member prior to entering.
3. All MBFC members 16 or over **must**, upon a request from bar-staff or a Committee member, produce valid proof that they meet the Government's mandated requirements for vaccinations. Please go to <https://www.wa.gov.au/government/covid-19-coronavirus/covid-19-coronavirus-what-you-can-and-cant-do> for information regarding valid proof.
4. All MBFC members 16 or over **must**, when providing proof of their vaccination status, also provide proof of their identity, ie a current drivers licence, health care card or Medicare card.

The Club is committed to providing a safe and compliant venue to all of our members, their guests, staff and volunteers. Therefore, I ask that everyone abides by these new requirements. If you choose not to, service will be refused, and you will be told to leave the Club's licenced area immediately.

I expect all members to continue to respect our staff and volunteers and their fellow members. Any harassment or verbal abuse of any person will not be tolerated, and membership suspensions will be imposed on anyone guilty of any inappropriate behaviour.

Please make sure that you log-in to the Safe WA app each time you visit the Club and of course, wear a mask when inside the Bar area.

If we all do the right thing and abide by these new requirements during this pandemic, we can all make a difference and protect our health and the health of others.
